# Periyar Arts College, Cuddalore-607001 Annual Report 2020-2021 & 2021-2022

Good morning, everybody. Historically, Cuddalore was a part of Chola country, later Thondai Nadu, and center of the state. During the British rule, the city of Cuddalore has the distinction of being the capital of Tamil Nadu for some time. Sri Appar Peruman and Thiru Arulprakasa Vallalar belonged to this city. It is also called as the Sugar Bowl of Tamil Nadu. I am proud to present the annual report of Periyar Arts College, which was established 58 years ago to flourish education in the city of Cuddalore. It is rich in sea and land and located on the silver beach of the Bay of Bengal.

Started in 1964, this college has been fulfilling the dream of college higher education to the rural poor students. The motto of this college is as follows:

#### "LEARNING IS WEALTH NONE COULD DESTROY

#### NOTHING ELSE GIVES GENUINE JOY"

In accordance with this Thirukural, our college serves as a platform for learning even for the poorest of the poor. The college is full of excellent teachers who are highly qualified and dedicated imparting good education to the students' community. I hope this annual report will bridge the gap between pre- pandemic and post- pandemic period, revealing all the events of the college to the world.

I am further happy to present the biennial annual report for 2020- 2021 and 2021-2022. Despite the closure of educational institutions due to covid19, learning and teaching have continued to take place online in our college. In the academic year 2020-2021, about 9422 students had applied online for admission to this college. 1573 (UG) & 390 (PG) students were admitted in the college with 20 departments in the academic year 2020-21. In the academic year 2021-22 1662 (UG) & 456 (PG) students were enrolled in 20 departments and 8 students have registered for Ph.D. The classes for first year students for the academic year 2021-22 commenced on 04.10.2021.

At the beginning of 2020, due to the impact of the Corona, the central and state governments imposed a complete curfew, and online classes were conducted in our college. Students wrote their exams in online mode. The pass percentage of students in both these academic years is given below

Disabled Welfare Unit is functioning in our college for the educational development of disabled students. Through this unit, guidance and alternative skills were provided to the students. Accordingly, on 09.05.2020, Disabled Welfare Unit celebrated Disability day with distribution of educational aids. Dr. J. Rajamurthy , Director of Government Welfare Corporation gave the special guest address in the function.

## **Green Student Corps**

A movement called GREEN CADET CORPS has been started in the academic year 2021-2022 with the aim of making the college campus green by planting various types of trees. In this, students will have an important role.

#### **National Cadet Corps**

The National Cadet Corps (NCC), considered the second arm of the Indian Army, is the most uniformed force in the world. Naval Squadron of National Cadet Corps was started in the year 1977 at Periyar Arts College, Cuddalore. After some gap in 2019, 5 Tamil Nadu National Cadet Corps, the sixth division of Naval Squadron, was launched again at Periyar Arts College, Cuddalore.

Troops of 50 students are undergoing training in uniform in our college affiliated to 5 Tamil Nadu Naval Division National Cadet Corps. Sub. Lt. Dr. Ira. Manokaran is working as a joint officer. This training helps our students to work more in the armed forces.

In our college, which is the naval unit of the National Cadet Corps, 2nd year anniversary training camps have been conducted since 2019. 50 students have been trained in our college and in 2019, a student of Tamil Department, Sr. Captain Santosh Kumar participated in the Republic Day event held in New Delhi. Ajith Kumar of III B.Com participated in Boat Pulling Ricardo Camp held in Chennai and won a gold medal.

Cadet Captain Vanaroja, a BCom third year student of our college, was trained in the Advanced Leadership Camp called ALC held at Coimbatore. Dinesh Kumar, a second year undergraduate student of Political Science, participated in the PLC camp known as Youth Leadership Camp. Last year, due to the Corona, the main camps of the National Cadet Corps camps were cancelled. The excellent performance of our college students in all the camps has resulted in our college getting the 1<sup>st</sup> position in Pondicherry Group of 5 Tamil Nadu National Cadet Force Naval Divisions to which our college is affiliated. Our college students took sailing training. They sailed from Puduvai to Karaikal in the sea and returned. The event was flagged off by the Deputy Governor of Pondicherry, Honourable, Tamilisai Soundararajan. A model of a warship (ship modelling) designed by our college students was awarded on this occasion.

## **Buildings reconstruction**

Our College buildings have been renovated through the Public Works department with a fund of one crore rupees from the Tamil Nadu government. Rs.1,36,00,000 is being provided by the Tamil Nadu government in this academic year to build two buildings with 32 classrooms. Also 354 chairs have been purchased by the higher education department fund at the cost of 10 lakhs. The construction work for the building with six classrooms is in progress at a cost of 60 lakhs from RUSA Fund. Rs.1 Crore from the NLC CSR fund for the construction of the auditorium has been allotted and approval has been obtained from the district collector. Lawns are being laid in front of the college to give it a beautiful look. Aquaculture and pond renovation work is in progress under the supervision of Zoology Department.

## **Education Scholarship**

The Government of Tamil Nadu has provided scholarship funds for the students studying in this college for the two academic years 2020-21 and 2021-22.

For the students of Backward Class and Most Backward Class Rs.41,30,223/- were given to 1644 students in the academic year 2020-21 and Rs.52,78,599/- were given to 1748 students in the academic year 2021-22.

In the academic year 2020-21, Schedule Caste Scholarship Rs. 1,19,73,038/- were given to 2205 students and Rs. 1,34,43,746/- were given to 2439 students in the academic year 2021-22.

Incentives are given every year to students who are studying Tamil medium in the college. Rs.10,72,800/- rupees have been given to 1192 students in the academic year 2020-21 and Rs.11,53,800/- were given to 1282 students in the academic year 2021-22.

In the academic year 2021-22, 59 students have received National Merit Scholarship. 10 differently-abled students have received educational Scholarship from the central government. In the academic year 2020-21, 34 students have received National Merit Scholarship. 3 differently-abled students have received educational Scholarship from the central government.

In the academic year 2021-22, the fund given by the Government of Tamil Nadu Rs.9,50,000/ has been distributed to all the Science Departments for the purpose of maintenance of laboratory equipment and machinery. Through this, science departments have purchased laboratory equipments and chemicals required for their departments.

For the academic year 2020-21, the fund given by the Government of Tamil Nadu Rs.1,75,000/, has been allocated to the science Departments for purchase of laboratory equipment and machinery & maintenance work.

CCTV cameras are installed in the college for administrative development. During this academic year, the process of National Disaster Management was implemented.

## **Board of Studies Members / Curriculum Design Committee**

Professors belonging to our college have played an important role in the board of studies, especially Dr. V. Panneer Selvam, Assistant Professor of Tamil, has worked as the head of the board of studies for the general Tamil for UG subjects of Tiruvalluvar University.

Dr. Vannamuthu as the Head of board of studies for UG Chemistry of Thiruvalluvar University and Dr. Kalaimani as the Member Board of Studies have worked well. In the Department of Physics, Dr. Tilak Kumar is working as the Head of board of studies UG Physics. Likewise, Dr. Abrama Sundari is working as a member of board of studies in the UG Economics. Dr. Sarmila, Department of Chemistry is working as a board of studies Chair of Seethalakshmi Ramasamy College.

Dr. Kannan, from the Department of Zoology, has worked as head of board of studies in autonomous colleges like St. Joseph's College, Cuddalore and Bharathidasan Arts College, Puducherry.

An article titled "The Stars of Tomorrow" about the excellent work done by the students of the social work department of our college in the field work, has been published in the magazine. For the Students of MSW, folk art training was given.

Arupadaiveedu Medical College, in collaboration with the social work department of our college, conducted a special medical camp. The Department of Social work has done a great job in the *Let us Teach and Learn Scheme* (Karppom Karpippom) for girls.

Our College's Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is functioning well. This cell is implementing various programs to motivate students. Especially CYBER SAFETY, WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM KALAM, ARCHERY TRAINING CAMP, SCOPE IN SPORTS, HEALTH AND FITNESS, ETHICAL CHARACTERISTICS, CONSUMER AWARENESS, COMMUNICATION SKILLS, CAREER GUIDANCE, NCC INTRO CLASS, YRC, SCHOLARSHIP- AN INSIGHT events are performed by IQAC.

On this auspicious occasion, I would like to express my hearty gratitude to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of the Tamil Nadu, the Minister of Higher Education and the Secretary of the Higher Education Department, who are contributing greatly to the success of Periyar Arts College, Cuddalore.
