1. TOOL USED

Parents' Feedback on Curriculum was asked to indicate their level of satisfaction with the fifteen statements accordingly for which they have to choose a score between 0 and 4 (4 – Strongly Agree, 3 – Agree, 2 – Not Sure, 1 – Disagree, 0 – Strongly Disagree). All the statements are compulsory. No time limit is specified for the completion of the Feedback, but

appropriate time is given to complete the same. Instead the list of fifteen statements, the Name of the Parent, Name of the Student, Year of Study (Batch), Degree and Mobile Number were asked. (Parents' Feedback on Curriculum was appended in Appendix)

2. SAMPLE SELECTION

Twenty courses that are run by the College were taken irrespective of the morning and evening shifts and English or Tamil as medium of instruction. This includes one Post-graduate Course namely, Master of Social Work (MSW), seven Undergraduate and Post-graduate Courses (namely, Economics, Commerce, Computer Science, History, Physics, Botany and Statistics) and twelve Undergraduate Courses (namely, Tamil, English, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Public Administration, Psychology, Business Administration, Computer Applications, Microbiology, Visual Communications and Political Science).

Two major disciplines were classified with these twenty courses namely, ARTS and SCIENCE. *Discipline of Arts* includes ten courses namely, Tamil, English, Economics, Commerce, History, Public Administration, Business Administration, Visual Communications, Political Science and Master of Social Work. *Discipline of Science* includes ten courses namely, Computer Science, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology, Botany, Statistics, Psychology, Computer Applications and Microbiology.

Parents of Students Sample of these courses were taken from each year of study. Undergraduate Courses were classified with the present first, second and third years, but Post-graduate Courses were combined with first and second years. Hence, 64 Courses were identified. The Distribution of Year-wise Course Disciplines of Courses with the selected number of parents of students was given in the following table.

They responded the questionnaire and indicate their level of satisfaction as per the given directions. The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2017-2020 batch) Undergraduate Commerce Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2017-2020 batch) Undergraduate Political Science Course Students. *This shows that the parents of third year undergraduate students of Commerce are more satisfied and the parents of Political Science are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.*

The total Percentage Index (85.88) of the 115 parents of third year (2017-2020 Batch) Undergraduate Arts Students from eight courses shows a favourable attitude towards these statements and indicates a high level satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2017-2020 batch) Undergraduate Chemistry Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of third year (2017-2020 batch) Undergraduate Computer Science Course Students. *This shows that the parents of third year undergraduate students of Chemistry are more satisfied and the parents of Computer Science are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.*

The total Percentage Index (92.13) of the 118 parents of third year (2017-2020 Batch) Undergraduate Science Students from nine courses shows a favourable attitude towards these statements and indicates a high level satisfaction towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2018-2021 batch) Undergraduate History Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2018-2021 batch) Undergraduate Commerce Course Students. *This shows that the parents of second year undergraduate students of History are more satisfied and the parents of Commerce Science are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.*

The highest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2018-2021 batch) Undergraduate Zoology Course Students and the lowest Percentage Index is obtained by the parents of second year (2018-2021 batch) Undergraduate Computer Science Course Students. This shows that the parents of second year undergraduate students of Zoology are more satisfied and the parents of Computer Science are less satisfied towards the faculty, teaching, learning and evaluation.
